We are living in changing and disruptive times where many of the previously held assumptions are being challenged at an ever increasing pace. The cosmetics industry is not immune to these changes and this event will provide an insight into some of the issues impacting upon the formulation of cosmetic products and ingredient selection.

Dr Helena Eixarch of TSGE Consulting will consider the regulatory environment and what lies ahead in the cosmetics sector. Focusing on a specific topic, the ramifications of bans on microplastics in cosmetic products will also be presented.

The variety of issues to be addressed include market reviews, the consumer's desire for more luxurious but cost-effective products, translation of trends in cosmetics from the Far East to Western markets, the future of naturals presented by Judi Beerling from Pertech Associates Ltd, and an overview of the growing interest in anti-pollution skincare products.
